Learning Opportunities on Placement	Involvement with MDT, able to negotiate locally with educator. Ward 16 (Burnley General Hospital) provides Occupational Therapy to complex patients who have been transferred from Royal Blackburn Hospital. Ward 19 is a rehab ward for patients who have been transferred from the acute wards at Blackburn hospital for rehabilitation input prior to discharge. The aim is to provide OT holistic assessments and interventions for patients with complex needs. This placement will enable students to enhance their understanding and skills when considering a variety of co-morbidities and patients' needs.
Strengths of the Placement	 The benefits of integration and MDT working and how joint assessments/visits promote efficient and effective discharge To shadow and have access to other Burnley General Hospital wards to enhance skills and understanding in orthopedics and rehabilitation. Patients with a variety of medical, cognitive, social and environmental needs
Limitations of the placement	Due to the complexity pf the patients, students who need to demonstrate autonomy may at times be limited due to the need for close supervision and guidance from a senior OT.
