Colour Filter

ColorVeil adds a customisable colour filter over your Desktop, Internet Brower, Video Player, Documents or Email



Eye Strain

ColorVeil can reduce screen brightness even below it's lowest setting.
This helps to reduce eye strain.



Dyslexia / SSS

ColorVeil can help people with Dyslexia and Scotopic Sensitivity Sydrome.
It applies a colour tint across the screen.

How to Turn ColorVeil On

Switch the PC on & log in with the generic log in details.

Click on the Chevron arrow to the right bottom of the screen. You will see a black, white & blue square (this might already be on the task bar) **ColorVeil** click on this to open the programme. Shown in Fig 1

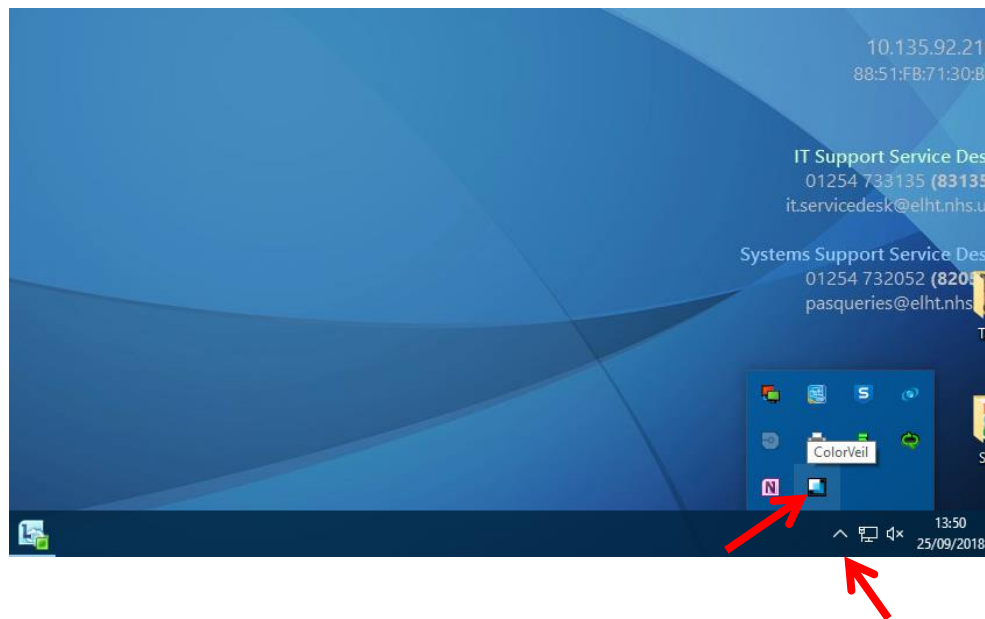
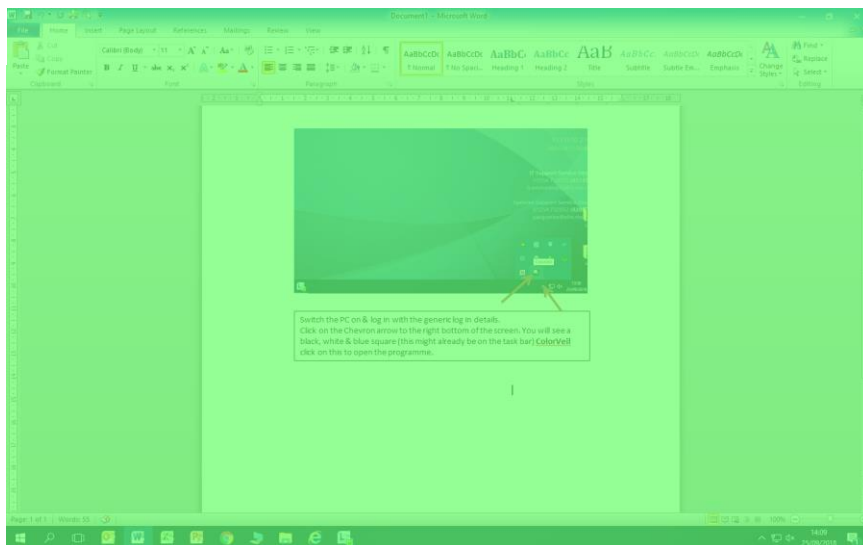

To Change the colour to your preference, right click the ColorVeil Icon, the ColorVeil Settings window will open.

Click the pick tab the Colour pallet will open select the colour you require then click OK, this window will now close. Use the Opacity slider to adjust lightness/darkness Shown in Fig 3 & 4

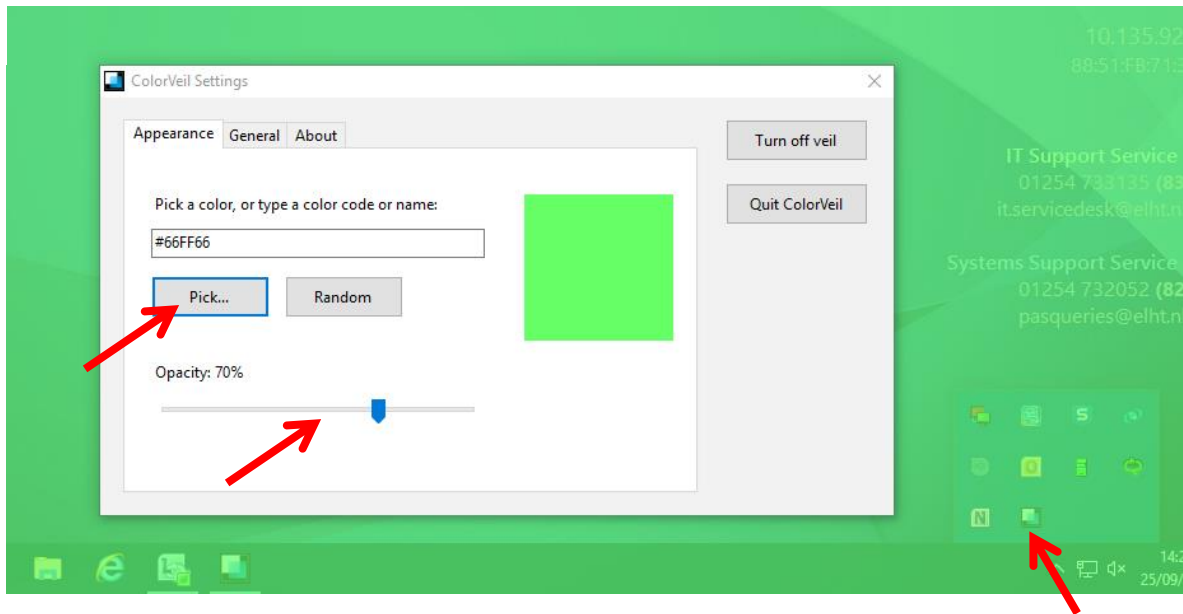
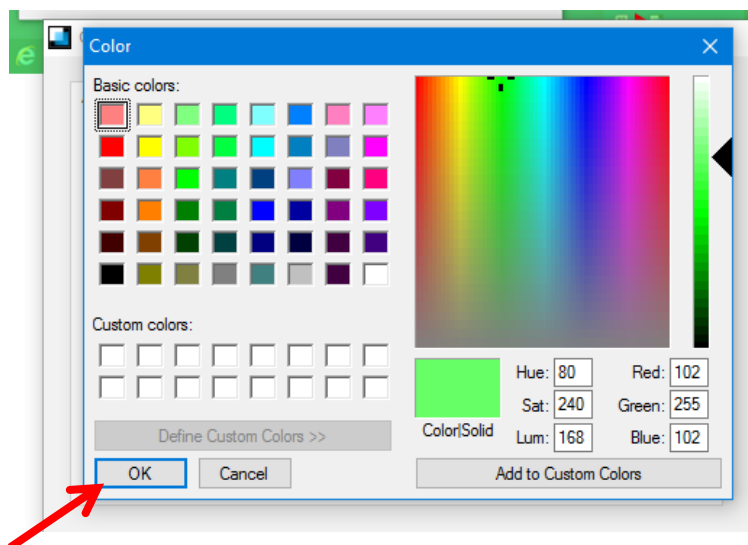
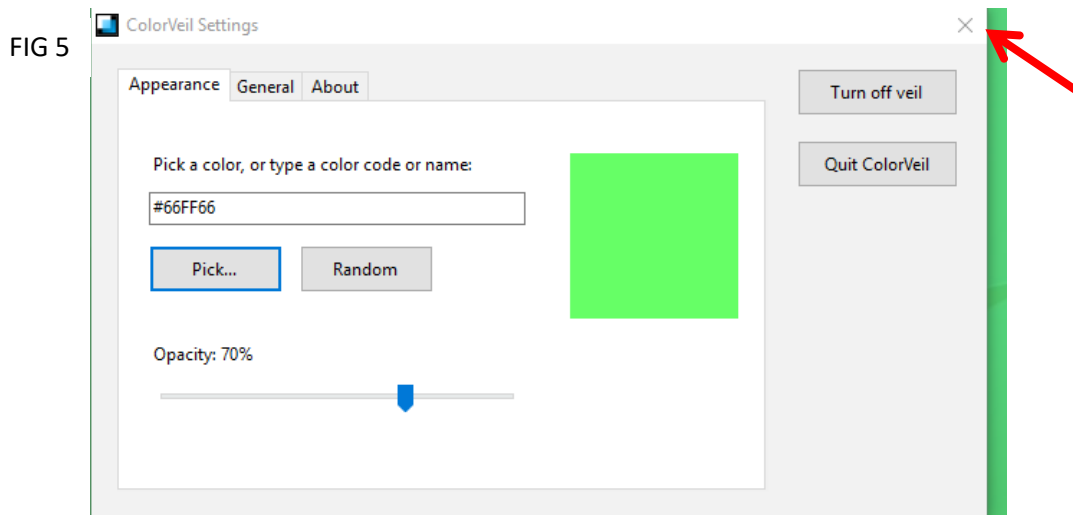

Once you have selected your chosen colour & clicked OK on the colour pallet click on the **X** in the top right corner. You will now return to the normal PC desktop. **DO NOT CLICK ON TURN OFF VEIL OR QUIT COLORVEIL** Shown in Fig 5



Once you have finished using the PC click the ColorVeil Icon and this will revert back to the original settings. Shown in Fig 6
