<p><b>Placement Experience Offered</b></p> <p>IHSS is a multiprofessional team providing rapid intervention to patients with an acute need and at risk of hospital admission or readmission. The team consists of Advanced Clinical Practitioners, Senior Community Practitioners, Community Practitioners, Specialist Occupational Therapists, Specialist Physiotherapist, Mental Health Nurse, Assistant practitioners, Advanced Technical instructor and support staff. IHSS provides a 2 hour response to visit and assess patients in their own homes</p>
<p><b>Strengths of the Placement</b></p> <p>Variety of workload Wide range of skills taught Opportunity to work in a holistic manner Supervision throughout the placement Good time management skills Experiencing Therapists working outside the 'traditional role' of OT.</p>
<p><b>Limitations of the placement</b></p> <p>Occasional there are times when you have to work late. No independent working. It is not appropriate for students to complete assessments without supervision. There is no opportunity to provide on -going rehabilitation as this is an acute short term service.</p>
