Post: FY1 Ophthalmology
The department: Outpatients in RBH Ward 6 and eye clinic and BGH Theatres 3 and 4 BGH
Main duties of the post: The FY1 doctor is responsible for the ward care patients in ward 6 and the maintenance of the patients' records. Trainees also have the opportunity to attend out-patient clinics and assist in theatres. Trainees should also perform an audit or project during their time in ophthalmology.

Where the post is based: Monday, Thursday, Friday Burnley General Hospital Tuesday and Wednesday in RBH
