If you have a uniform for placements from university, this is acceptable. • No jeans/tracksuits/casual-wear. • Long hair is tied back and away from the face and secured with modest bands and clips so that it does not interfere with the performance of duties. • Closed toe, flat, dark shoes must be worn in clinical areas at all times. • Religious or cultural headwear which must be fully tucked in around the collar bone and not dangling • One plain metal wedding ring only/small plain earrings/no wrist watches • No nail varnish or acrylic nails <p>(Taken from the ELHT Uniform/Dress Code Policy)</p>
