### Individual Placement Description

**Post:** FY2 Trauma & Orthopaedics

#### The department

- Large department with 20 consultants and 30 junior grade medical staff members.
- Multidisciplinary set up with close cooperation with Orthogeriatricians, Trauma Coordinators and Allied Health Professionals on a daily basis.
- 2 daily multidisciplinary ward rounds.
- Split site working with Trauma surgery at the RBH site and Elective surgery at the BGH site.
- Wards RBH: B22 (Hip Fracture ward) B24 (Trauma Ward)
- Ward BGH: 15 Elective ward
- Purpose built Fracture clinic suite with 8 consultation rooms (RBH)
- Theatres RBH: Theatre 10 and 11 (Trauma)
- Theatres BGH: 5 Elective Theatres (Wilson Hey Complex)

#### Main duties of the post

##### Day Job

- Delivery of inpatient care to Trauma patients at RBH site.
- Support and supervise ward-based FY1 Doctors.
- Participate in daily Orthopaedic Consultant ward round.
- Participate in daily Orthogeriatric Consultant ward round.
- Attend daily teaching in the Trauma Meeting.
- Attend Monday afternoon Orthopaedic trainees teaching programme.
- Attend Monthly Audit and three monthly Morbidity and mortality meetings.
- Attend Orthopaedic Foundation Doctors forum every month.
- Complete 1 audit project during post.
- Attend Fracture and Elective clinics per rota
- Participate in theatre sessions as 1<sup>st</sup> assistant on BGH and RBH site per rota.
- Ward cover on Elective ward at BGH.

##### On Call

##### First on call

- Primary review of all Trauma referrals from RBH Accident and Emergency department as well as peripheral urgent care and walk-in centres and General Practitioners in the East Lancashire area.
- Primary review includes: History taking, examination, requesting preliminary investigations and first-line management of Orthopaedic emergencies under the supervision of the on call ST trainee and Consultant.
- Attend Trauma meeting and post-take ward round.

## **2<sup>nd</sup> on call**

- Primary review of ward referrals.
- Ward Cover on Trauma wards B22 and B24 after 5pm.
- Attend Trauma meeting and post-take ward round.

## **Night Shifts**

- Will cover both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> on call duties.
- Participation in multi-disciplinary hospital at night team including Max-Fax/ENT/Urology cover for one weekend in total during the post.

## **Typical working pattern**

### **See Work Schedule provided**

- Normal working day 8am to 5pm.
- On call day 8am to 8.30pm.
- Day starts with Trauma meeting and ends with hand over to on call or night team.
- On call doctors present patients at the trauma meeting and participate in post-take ward round
- Duties alternate between ward-based cover (including FY1 supervision) and theatre/clinic sessions according to a weekly timetable.
- Ward based doctors will take part in the Orthopaedic or Orthogeriatric daily multidisciplinary ward round.

**There may or may not be out of hours work included.**
